

Re-entry Procedure on M1 Motorway

1. Heading South

During the hours of 6am and midnight a customer can go to the operator lane and get a receipt for the transaction.

This receipt can be produced to the operator in lane 1, 2 or 3 at the main Plaza within 3 hours so it can be scanned for a free re-entry.

The Automatic lanes are open 24 hours and the customer can press a button to get the receipt for producing at the main plaza.

If the customer arrives at the automatic lane at the main plaza they can press the help button and give the controller the number off the receipt and be processed for re-entry.

2. Heading North

The customer must go to an operator lane and get a receipt for their transaction. When re-entering the Motorway at the North Ramp on the Donore Road they can go to the operator and have their receipt scanned to get the free passage for re-entering the motorway.

Between midnight and 6am the customer can get the receipt scanned at the automatic machine or else call the control room and give the controller the number off the receipt.

If the customer goes through the automatic lane at the main plaza they will not get a receipt and will have to pay at the North ramp for re-entry as the receipt is necessary to process the re-entry.

3. ETC customers.

The system allows for re-entry to not be charged to their account if they are re-entering the motorway within 3 hours heading in the same direction.
