



Draft Bye-Laws for the M4 Kinnegad-Enfield-Kilcock Motorway

The National Roads Authority, in exercise of the powers conferred under section 61 of the Roads Act, 1993, as amended by section 274 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, proposes to make bye-laws in respect of the use of the M4 Kinnegad-Enfield-Kilcock Motorway.

The purpose of the bye-laws is to give effect to the Toll Scheme for the M4 Kinnegad-Enfield-Kilcock Motorway as adopted by the Board of the Authority in November 2001.
