



Have your say on the development of cycling infrastructure in Ireland

Transport Infrastructure Ireland is inviting the public and anyone that is interested to make their views heard on the development of a new National Cycle Network (NCN). This ambitious plan aims to link towns, cities and other key destinations across Ireland with a safe, connected and inviting cycle network.

Over recent months, we have been working closely with stakeholders to gather information on existing cycle infrastructure provision and looking for opportunities where new facilities can be developed. Arising from this, plans for the NCN have been developed and we are sharing them for feedback to help us create the best possible proposal.

Following our analysis of public feedback, a final report will be completed in August 2022 on the proposed National Cycle Network incorporating the feedback received. Detailed plans for the roll out of the NCN over the coming years will then be developed.

The consultation is open from the 4th of May to the 7th of June 2022.
