 209 RSA's








Road Safety Auditors' Clients

- Recommend solutions





When is a road safe enough?


- Road safety is difficult to measure

- Scenario's: "What if..." and "How serious is the consequence?






Auditor's findings

- No Stage 1 Audit carried out (Stage 2)
- Equipment still on site (Stage 3)
- Unsolved issues from previous stages (Stage 4)
- Recommendations are ignored (all stages)
