Collision Prevention Programme What is it?

"A Garda Síochána / Local Authority partnership initiative to identify traffic collision prone locations and to take preventative remedial action"



Collision Prevention Programme Who attends meetings?

- Local Authority
 - Road Design & Area Engineers, Road Safety Officer
- NRA Road Safety Engineer (If required)

Safe Road Infrastructure Design



HD 19 – Road Safety Audit Major Road Scheme

A scheme which is on or which joins a motorway or a divided all-purpose road, designed in accordance with the NRA DMRB





Minor Road Scheme

A scheme designed in accordance with the NRA DMRB other than a Major Road Scheme





Maintenance Road Scheme

A scheme involving pavement overlay or inlay works which regulate the camber of the existing road, or edge strengthening of an existing road.



Major & Minor Signing Scheme

Major Signing Scheme

A signing scheme where the sign supports are designed in accordance with BD 51, or the overall area of the sign board is greater than 10m².

Minor Signing Scheme

All other signing schemes, except those approved through the NRA Traffic Signs and Road Marking Approvals Procedure.



Lining Scheme

A road marking scheme which results in a change to existing road markings, except one approved through the NRA

- Must be sent to the Director of the overseeing organisation for decision
- •For National Roads the overseeing organisation is the NRA
- Decision is final

• The scheme cannot get approval for latter stage audits until this process is carried out and in the case of Stage 3 Audits the road cannot be open to traffic until it is completed








Eliminate / Relocate / Protect Hazards
